April 25 Trip Planned to Rancho Los Alamitos

A visit to Rancho Los Alamitos in Long Beach is being planned for Saturday, April 25. Rancho Los Alamitos, the "Ranch of the Little Cottonwoods," is a Long Beach City Landmark and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The Rancho has a continuous history of habitation that stretches back for more than 1500 years and reflects the many people who have called it home - from the first people, the Tongva, to the Spanish and Mexican colonists, right up to the Yankee farmers of the midtwentieth century. The 7½-acre site includes four acres of nationally significant historic gardens, a ranch house (1790-1933), and a restored barnyard of the early 20thcentury working ranch.


Members will meet at the Rancho (located near Long Beach State) at 10 AM. A docent led tour of the Ranch House and historic gardens will begin at 10:30. Lunch will be served from 12 to 1 PM. Public hours for the Rancho are 1 to 5 PM. We will have the property to ourselves as we tour and dine.

At noon, the group will meet at the Ramada Tent for a catered lunch consisting of California Caesar Salad with Herbed Croutons, Rancho Famous BBQ Tri-tip of Beef with Rancho's own Smoking Gun BBQ Sauce, Grilled Garden Vegetables, Spanish Rice and Pico de Gallo, Flour Tortillas, and Caramel Cheesecake. Coffee, tea and water are included. There is a 50 person limit for the event, so if there are more than 50 the trip will be open to the first 50 people who sign up. Although most of the gardens are wheelchair accessible, there are some limitations on narrow trails. If applicable, we will set up one docent group for handicapped and limited mobility members. The cost for the event is \$40 per person. That includes all costs for the visit including meal, tax, gratuity, service charge and tip for the docent. There is parking provided at the Rancho.
