RECIPE OF THE MONTH

CRACKER BARREL PEACH COBBLER



Ingredients:

Bottom Layer:

¼ cubs Bisquick
1 cup milk
½ cup unsalted butter
½ t. cinnamon
¼ t. nutmeg

Filling:

2 15-ounce cans sliced peaches in heavy syrup, drained
¼ cup sugar

Topping:

1 T. melted butter
½ t. cinnamon
½ cup light brown sugar
¼ cup sliced almonds (optional)

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees.
2. Generously coat an 8-inch square baking dish with nonstick spray.
3. In a medium bowl, combine Bisquick, milk ½ cup butter, ½ teaspoon cinnamon and nutmeg. Mix until combined. Pour mixture into prepared baking dish.
4. In another medium bowl, combine peaches and sugar. Mix well.
5. Pour over bottom batter in baking dish. DO NOT MIX.
6. Place baking dish in preheated oven and bake for 45 minutes.

7. Remove from oven but leave oven on.
8. In small bowl, combine 1 tablespoon melted butter, ½ teaspoon cinnamon, brown sugar and almonds (if desired).
9. Sprinkle mixture evenly over top of cobbler and bake for 10 minutes.
10. Remove from oven and allow to cool for 10 to 15 minutes.
11. Serve warm with vanilla ice cream.

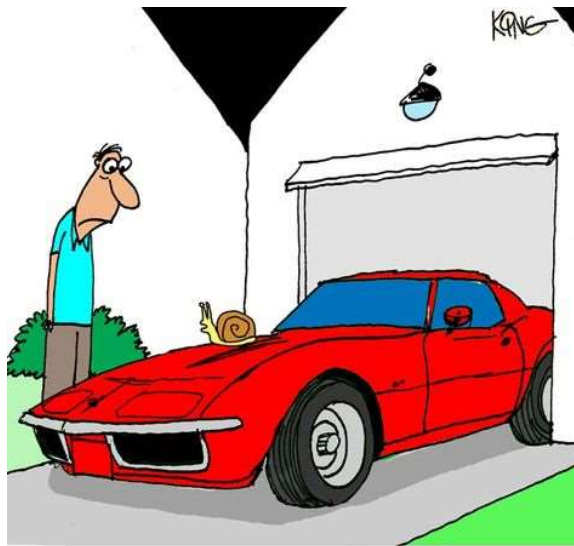

We have a full meeting agenda for September. We have a brief annual meeting and then our usual business meeting. We want everyone to understand what governors will be voting electronically on in the next month or so.

All of the Competition Rulebook changes will be discussed so each governor can share the details with you. There are lots of items to vote on. Please go to the website and click on the tab that shows Competition clarifications and rulebook updates. You can also go to the Competition tab and find the changes listed there with more detailed information. It's a lot so be sure to have some time to set aside to read them.

- The new chapter 12 Supplemental programs will be explained as well as the fees to support the programs. There are several sections to vote on.
- New safety program for workers at each event. RCDs have worked hard to be sure the workers are safe
- New classes to separate groups by generation (C1, C2, C3 etc.) lots of changes.
- Drag event updates.

The changes will be part of the online voting process. Instead of voting for the rulebook as a whole, you now have the opportunity to vote on each change separately.

At the meeting, we will be voting on the dues increase. As a reminder, NCCC has not had a dues increase for so long no one can recall a date. I was President 25 years ago and there were no dues increase during my term - and none up to now. Expenses go up that we cannot control – insurance premiums, publication costs and membership cards/postage. Our membership numbers have stayed fairly consistent. Please let your RE know how to vote. We are still looking at ways to cut expenses that we can control. Again, if you have suggestions, please contact your regional officer or me.

The National Corvette Museum is gearing up for the Anniversary Celebration along with the new inductees to the NCM Hall of Fame. There will be plant tours offered during the event so check out the website to see if there are still spots available.

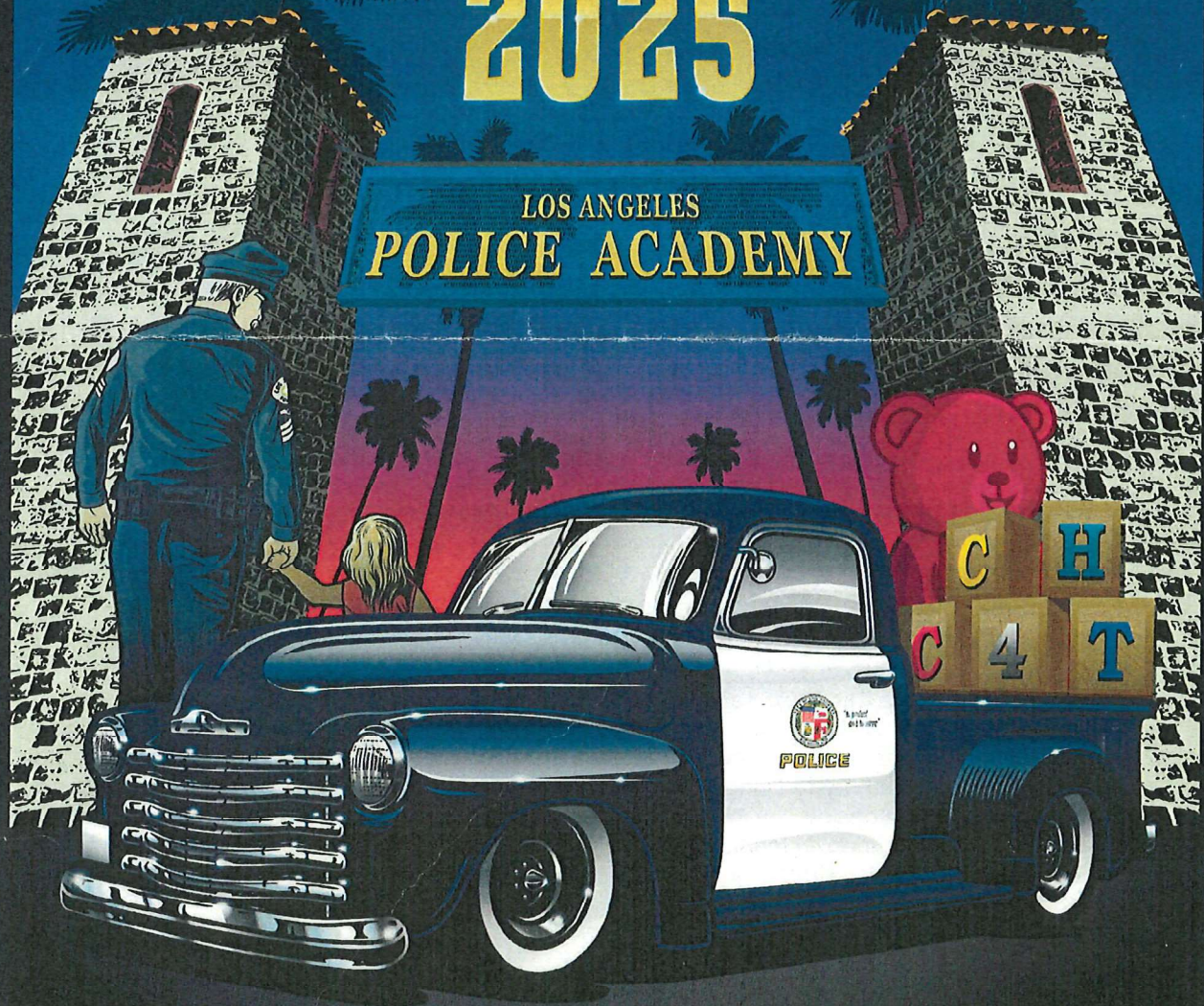
