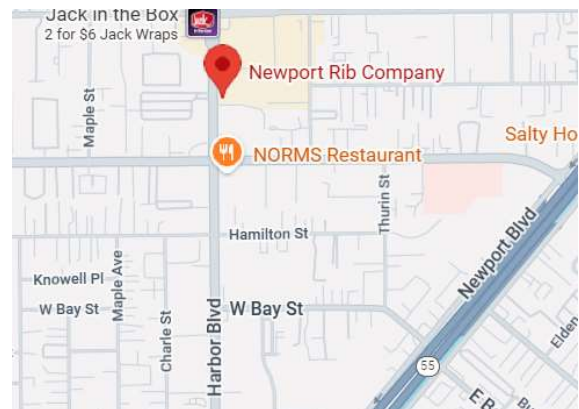

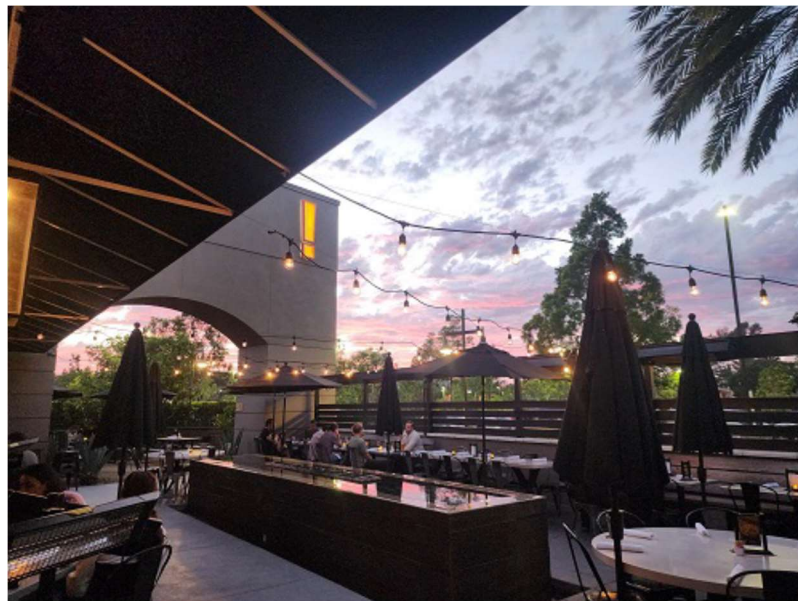

New Years Soup



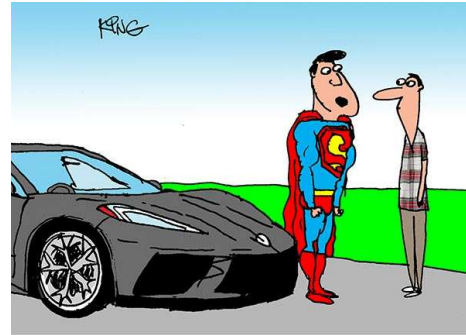
Ingredients:

- 2 (15.8-ounce) cans black-eyed peas, undrained
 - 3 (14-ounce) cans chicken broth
 - 2 (14-1/2-ounce) cans diced tomatoes
 - 1/2 cup chopped onion
 - 2 celery stalks, chopped
 - 4 cloves garlic, minced
 - 2 cups diced cooked ham
 - 1 teaspoon salt
 - 1 teaspoon black pepper
 - 3 cups chopped fresh collard greens
 - Hot sauce for splashing
1. In a 6-quart slow cooker, combine all ingredients except collard greens and hot sauce; mix well. Add collard greens on top.
 2. Cover and cook on LOW 6 to 8 hours, or until greens are tender. Splash with hot sauce before serving.

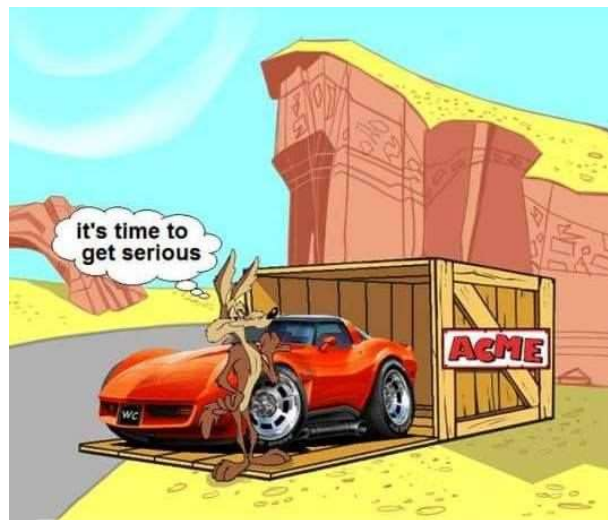

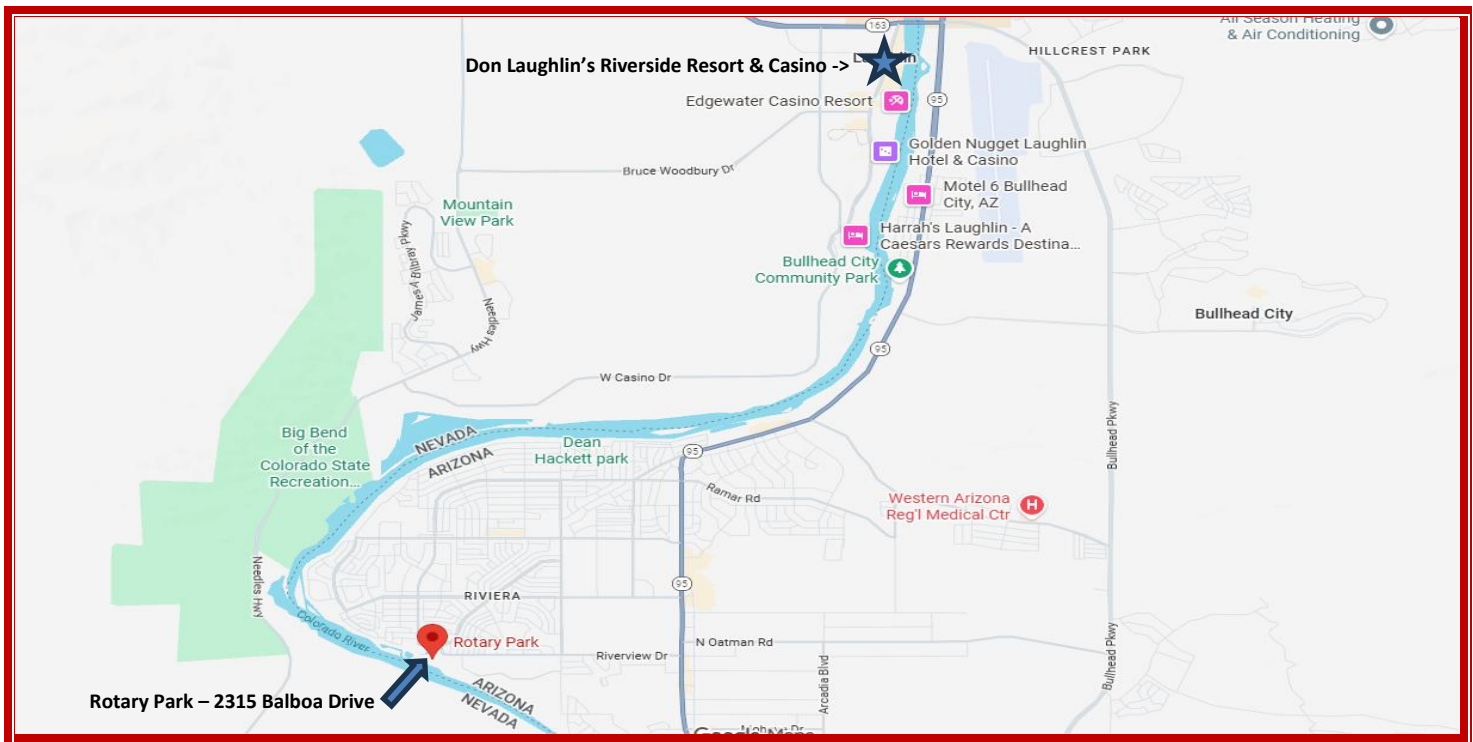

Competition Update January 2026

In addition to our traditional NCCC National Competition Speed and Non-Speed Points Programs, we now have three exciting new limited series Competition Programs for the 2026 NCCC Competition Season. Participants can enter a minimum set of qualifying NCCC events and attend Convention to battle it out for a National Title in their individual program category. (1.) FCOA Competition Program is for FCOA members ages 9-16 to participate in 4 different categories as follows: Stingray (9-10), Grand Sport (11-12), Z06 (13-14) and ZR1

(15-16) by attending a minimum of 21 Non-Speed events plus the Shootout at Convention.

(2.) Young Guns Competition Program is for our NCCC Youth members ages 16-26 to participate in 3 different categories as follows: (C1-C4), (C5-C6) and (C7-C8) by attending a minimum of 28 Speed events plus the Shootout at Convention.

(3.) ZORA Competition Program is for our NCCC members of any age to participate in 8 categories as follows: C1, C2, C3, C4, C5, C6, C7 and C8 by attending a minimum of 42 Speed events plus the Shootout at Convention. These programs do not track Points; they track the number of qualifying events attended. Everyone starts with a clean slate at Convention. These 3 programs are self-funded by the participants for National Awards but are still seeking Individual Category Award(s)/Contingency Prizes from Individuals, Clubs, Regions and/or Corporate Sponsors. Please contact me at rene500Z06@comcast.net for further details. Let's get the young crowd interested in participating and staying in our organization. For individual Competition Program Rules, please go to our NCCC Website, under Competition and click on the respective program link. Hosts, Clubs, Regions, the programs are in place, please give your Regional members a chance by putting on at least the required number of qualifying events so they can come to Convention and take home some of the Top Awards. This is not a one-man show or a few of us show, it takes all of us to make it work. Let's get it done. Another exciting change comes in the form of Autocrossing and Drag Racing Re-naming of the car Classes. Please note that only the name change went into effect, the class matrix is still the same as the previous season even if a few cars got re-shuffled into new classes. No need to go buy new wheel and tire sizes. Wishing all the competitors that are strategizing early, a great Competition Season and go get yourself a National Title at Convention or one of the coveted National Top 15.
