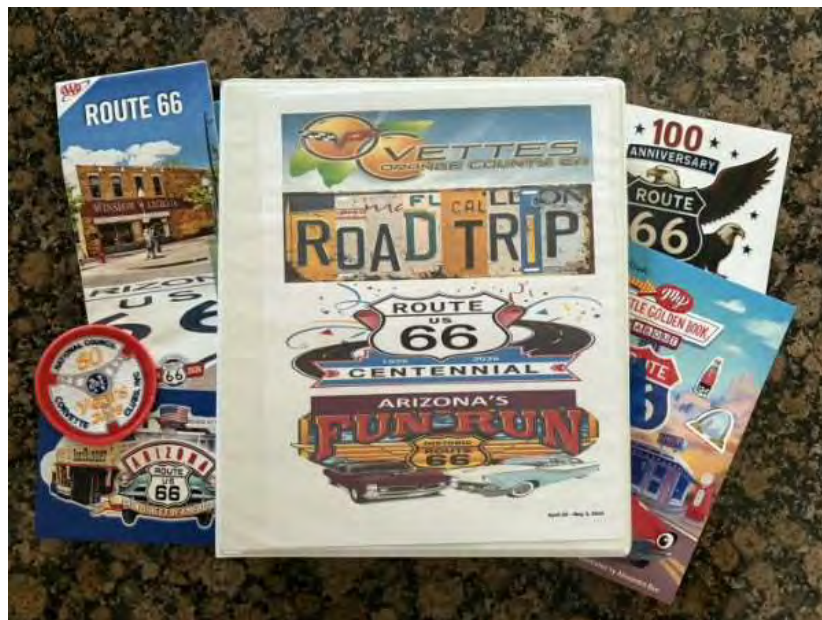
ROUTE 66

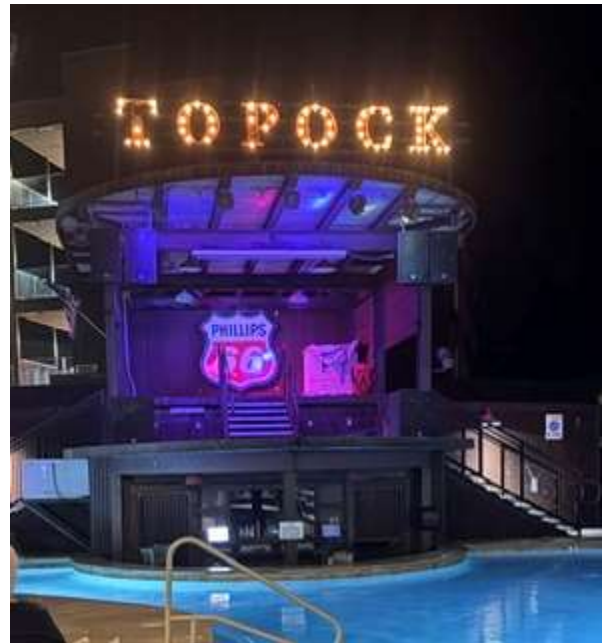

RECIPES OF THE MONTH

Corvette Summer Drink

Route 66 Chili

If you need a new go-to summertime cocktail, you must try a Corvette Summer drink. This cocktail is a refreshing combination of tequila, fresh grapefruit, lime juice and a splash of tonic water that you'll want to drink all summer long.

Corvette Summer Drink



PREP/TOTAL TIME:
10 mins total



SERVINGS:
1

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 ounces grapefruit juice
- 1 ounce tequila
- 1/2 ounce lime juice
- Ice cubes
- Splash tonic water



ROUTE 66 CHILI



3 pounds trimmed boneless pork shoulder, cut into 1-inch pieces
All purpose flour
1/2 cup olive oil
3/4 cup chopped onion
4 poblano chilies, chopped
1/4 cup chopped garlic
1 28-ounce can diced tomatoes in juice
2 19-ounce cans enchilada sauce
1 12-ounce bottle amber ale
1 7-ounce can diced green chilies
1 tablespoon ground cumin
1 tablespoon chili powder
Sour cream
Sliced green onions

Dredge pork in flour to coat; shake off excess. Heat 1/4 cup olive oil in a large pot over medium-high heat. Add pork and brown on all sides in batches, about 8 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, transfer pork to a large bowl.

Add the remaining 1/4 cup olive oil to the same pot. Add the onion and sauté until translucent, about 4 minutes. Add the poblano chilies and garlic and sauté for 2 minutes. Mix in the pork, diced tomatoes with their juice, enchilada sauce, ale, diced green chilies, cumin, and chili powder. Simmer until the meat is tender and the chili thickens slightly, stirring occasionally, for about 1 hour. Serve the chili with sour cream and sliced green onions.
